

CRAFT:

Sparkly Christmas Tree Ornament

Make a beautiful Christmas ornament. So pretty and sparkly people won't believe it's handmade!

What you'll need:

- A Styrofoam ball (from craft stores)
- One thumbtack
- Colourful sequins
- Sewing pins
- Ribbon
- Scissors



How to make it:

1. Cut enough ribbon to make a 'loop' of ribbon 5 cm long.
2. Push the thumbtack through the ribbon and into the styrofoam ball so you have a hanging loop.
3. Carefully thread a pin through a sequin, and push the pin into the styrofoam ball.
4. Continue doing this until the whole ball is covered in colourful sequins.
5. You now have a pretty sparkly ornament to hang on your tree!

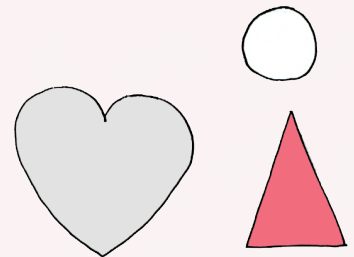


The Christmas Window Fairy

Make your very own fairy to glimmer and shine in the window!

You will need:

- White cardboard/heavy-duty craft paper
- Thread or wool (yarn)
- Baking paper or tracing paper
- Sparkly pens
- Textas
- Blue-Tack
- Glue stick



Instructions:

1. Cut a heart shape from tracing paper for your angel's wings. Decorate with sparkly pens any way you like.
2. Cut a triangle out of the white cardboard and a circle (these will be the fairy's dress and wings).
3. Glue the triangle and circle on the wings (see diagram).
4. Cut strands of wool and decorate the sides of the face as hair.
5. Draw the fairy's face and decorate her dress.
6. Stick to the window with Blue-Tack and watch the sun shine through and make her sparkle!
